- 1966 He began his studies as a dancer
- 1968 Began his dance studies at the Conservatory of Geneva. Amongst his teachers were: M. Besobrasova, S. Jonesco, S. Tscheremissinof, G. Flay and S. Golovine
- 1971 Started dancing in diverse Swiss shows.
- 1972 As choreographer and dancer, he created a Sicilian Folk Dance Company that ran successfully in all the important Swiss cities.  
Thanks to the success of this company, he obtained the « Diploma ad Honorem » from the National Italian Tourist Board.
- 1973 Graduated at the art school of Geneva « Les Arts Deco », majoring in Graphic arts and Painting.
- 1975 From 1975 to 1978, he danced for the « Grand Théâtre » of Geneva ballet company (Balanchine repertoire).
